



Mass Spectrometry-based Proteomics Workshop

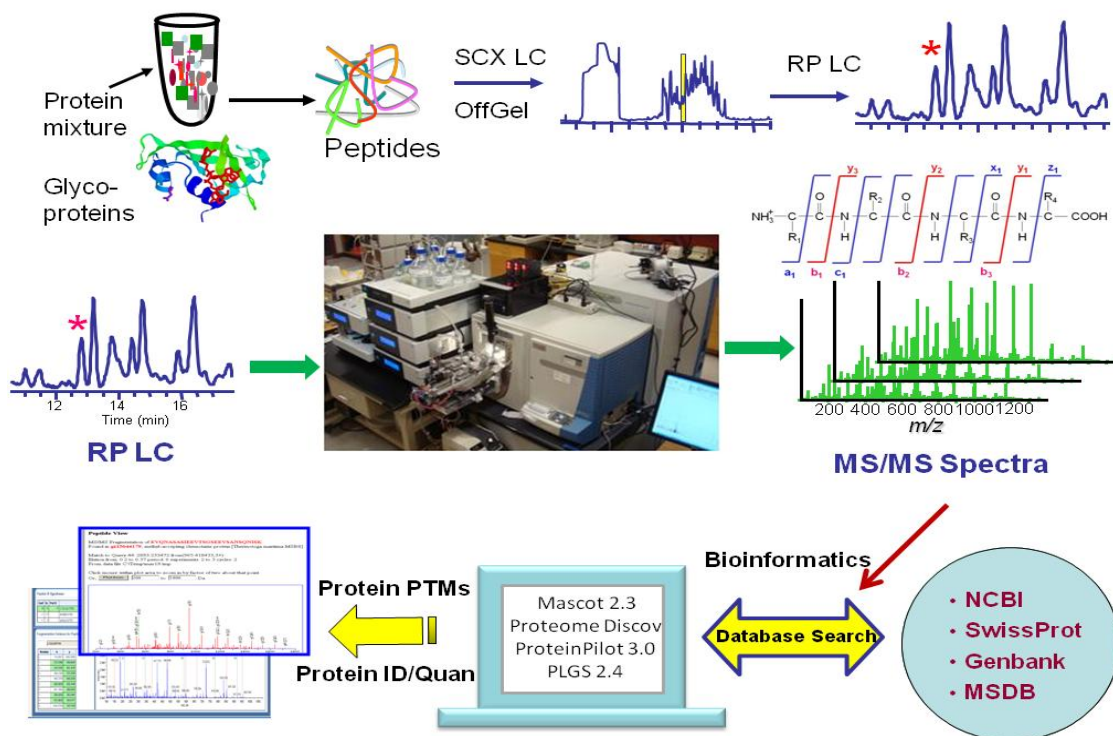

We are pleased to announce a three-day workshop comprising both lectures and practical lab-based training using advanced mass spectrometry techniques and bioinformatics, with the first 2 days focusing on proteomics and the last day on glycomics. This course is particularly targeted towards undergraduate, graduate students and postdocs. There is no charge for this course and lunch will be provided. The number of places available is limited to 20; all 20 will participate in the first 2 days, but only 8 will continue through the third day of glycomics. We anticipate over-enrollment so early application is strongly recommended.
